- Advocacy campaigns and increased public awareness
- Hospital Palliative Care Teams
- Children palliative home care

Phase 3 Strategic framework and systemic change

- Strategy for the care of children with LLC
- Strategy implementation team
- Advocacy campaigns
- Implementation of pilot projects
- Private funding

Educational Outcomes

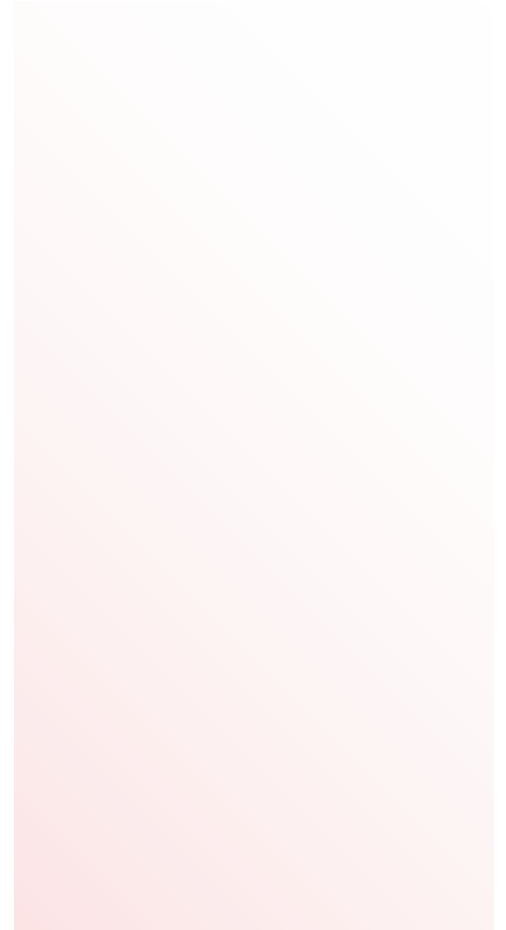
- PPC included in curriculum
